Thank you for your interest in becoming a Youth Council member.

To help you know what to expect, we've put together a short overview and guide for what comes next in the application process.

Futures For All is a charity that helps state-educated young people like you. Every year, **we invite 20 young 15-17-year-olds (from years 10 – 12) to join our Youth Council** to amplify their voice and represent fellow students.

- ☒ You'll join a youth advisory board that helps shape our work through regular consultation – meeting online once a month and supporting us throughout the year. You could be co-creating or sharing insights on programmes, products and resources; feeding back on impact surveys; writing letters to Ministers on youth initiatives and blog articles about your experiences; recording short videos to inform and inspire young people, and so much more.
- ☒ Get involved with opportunities which vary from year to year – which could include attending or speaking at educational events, round table meetings with policy makers, MPs or employers, or campaign launches.
- ☒ Receive training opportunities in press and media, meeting chairperson and secretarial duties, as well as a full induction and chances to advance your personal development.

How to apply: Your 3-step process

01

Submit your application

Complete and submit the online application form in full to tell us a bit more about you, why you'd like to join our Youth Council and confirm your Parent/Carer's contact details.

You must submit your application before midnight on Friday, the 28th of November 2025. Any applications received after this deadline will not be considered.

02

Join a short interview

Once we have reviewed the applications, if we'd like to know more about you, we'll contact you to arrange an interview – either online, in person, or on the phone.

Please don't worry about the prospect of an interview with us. We will keep it as informal as possible, and we will ask you which method of contact you are most comfortable with.

03

Attend a welcome event

If your application is successful, we will be in touch to confirm your appointment as a Youth Council member and invite you to attend a fully funded 2-day welcome event.

This in-person event is expected to take the form of a residential in February 2026, where you will receive full training on your role as well as a schedule for all future monthly online meetings.

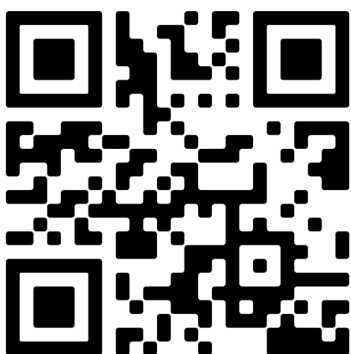
